Brown Rudnick LLP is a limited liability partnership registered in England and Wales with company number OC300611 and its registered office at 8 Clifford Street, London W1S 2LQ (the "UK LLP"). This statement applies to the UK LLP entity only and does not apply to our affiliate operating in the United States, also named Brown Rudnick LLP, which is organized under the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.


Pursuant to s.54 of the Modern Slavery Act 2015, we are required to produce a statement each financial year ending 31 January.

As an office based law firm, our supply chain includes facilities such as cleaning, security and catering services for the benefit of our clients and staff. We are committed to ensuring that there is no modern slavery or human trafficking in our supply chain or in any part of our business.

In line with our legal and ethical obligations for the year ending 31st January 2019 we have:

- Identified that suppliers in the cleaning, security and catering services provide a greater risk of committing the criminal offences. We have contacted our suppliers to request confirmation that they have policies and procedure in place to ensure they are compliant with the Modern Slavery Act 2015.
- Agreed to provide training on the Modern Slavery Act 2015 to staff who regularly interface with high risk vendors of Brown Rudnick LLP.
- Agreed to annually review our supply chain to check for any areas of risk with regards to modern slavery or human trafficking.
